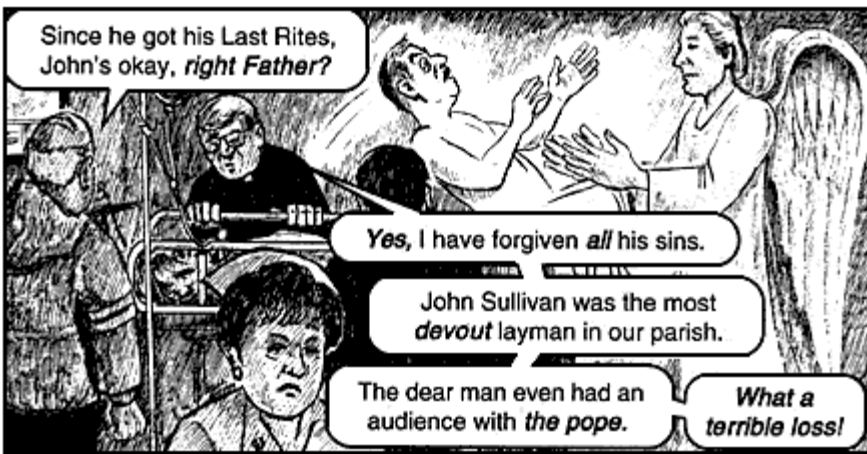

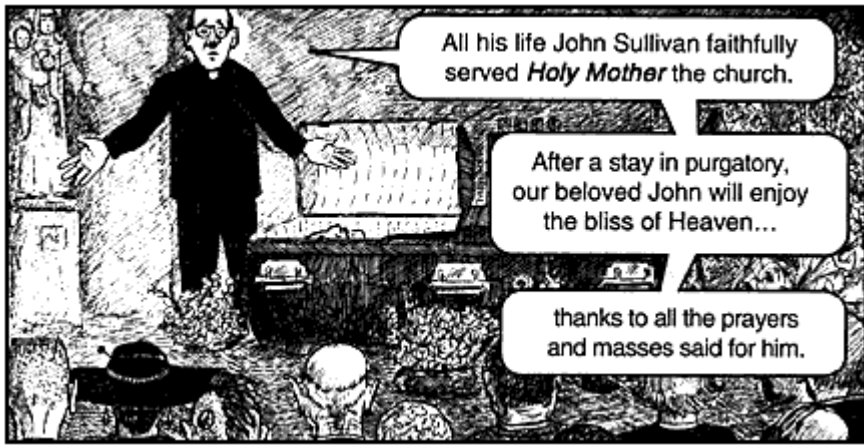


This is a tract from Chick Tracts. It shows some of the things wrong with catholicism, but it doesn't get salvation right itself either. This tract will do a catholic no good.

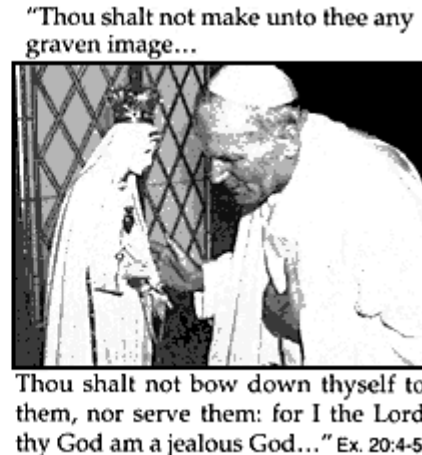
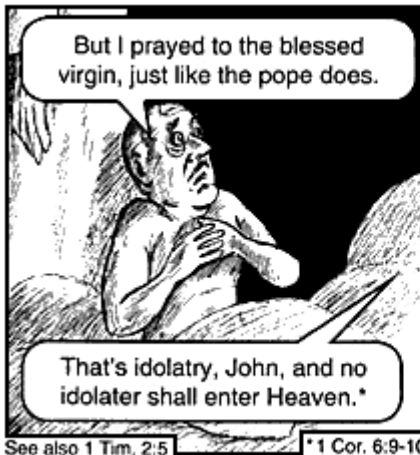
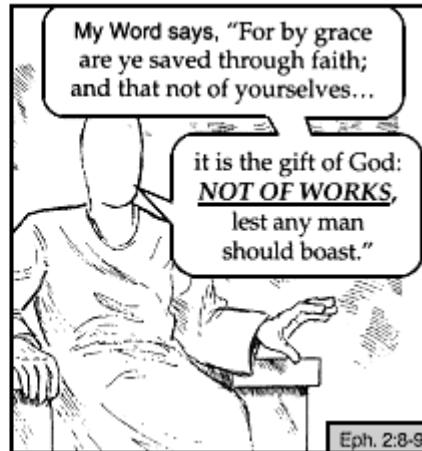


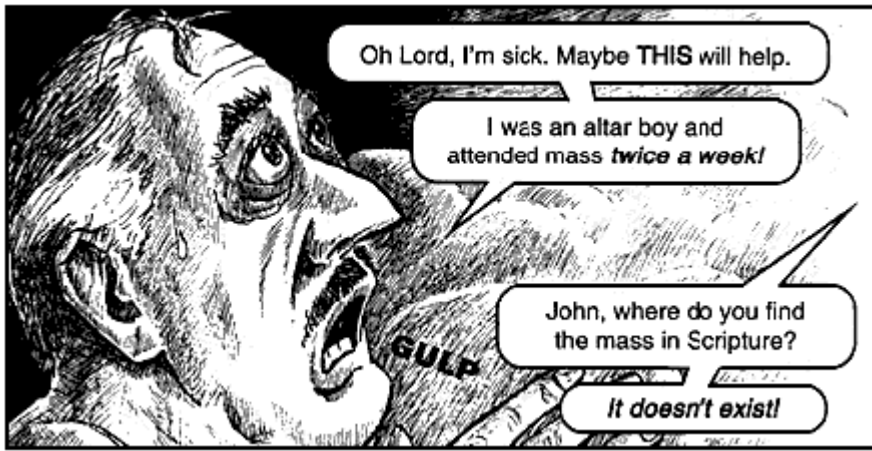


Here, being good enough is a mistake, but further down the tract, they say repenting of your sins (being good enough) is required for salvation.



But John's name wasn't in the Book of Life*, so he heard these terrible words:



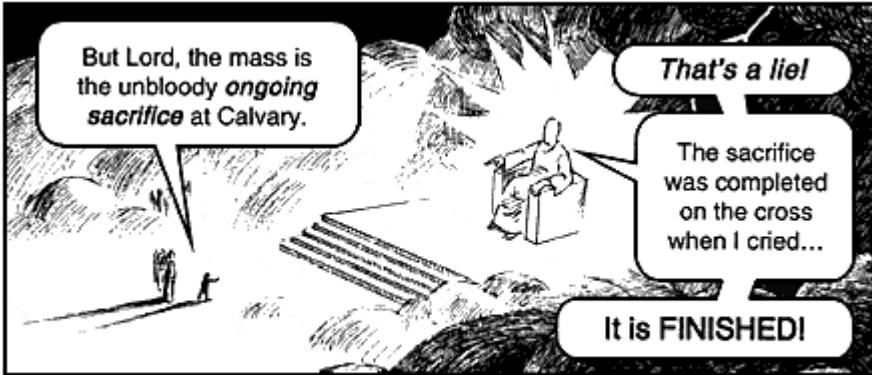


Oh Lord, I'm sick. Maybe **THIS** will help.

That's a lie!

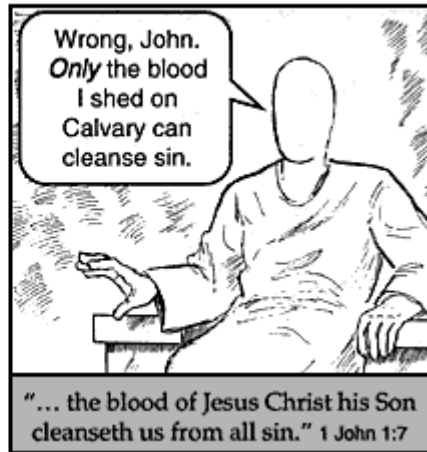
The sacrifice was completed on the cross when I cried...

"But this man (Jesus), after he had offered **ONE SACRIFICE** for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God;" Heb. 10:12

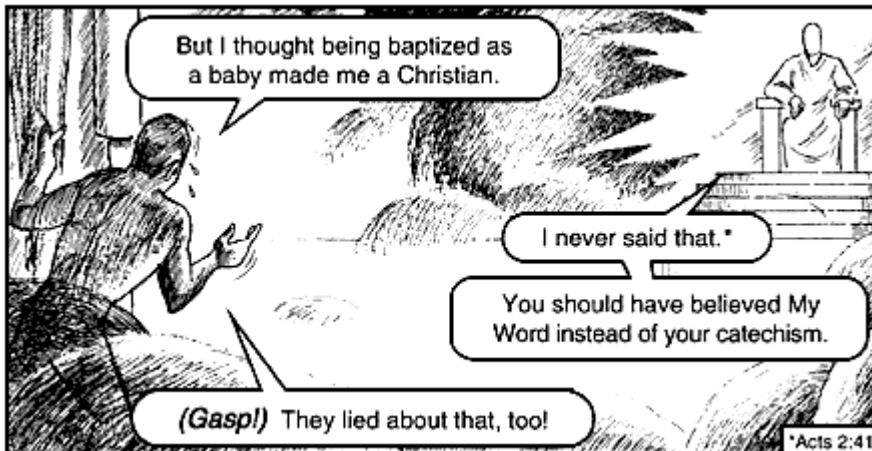


But Lord, *I know* my baptism cleansed me of original sin. **Right?**

"... the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin." 1 John 1:7



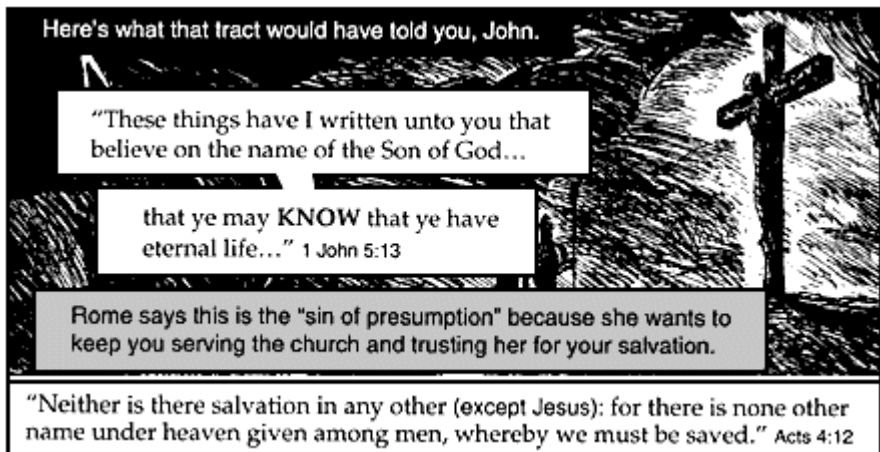
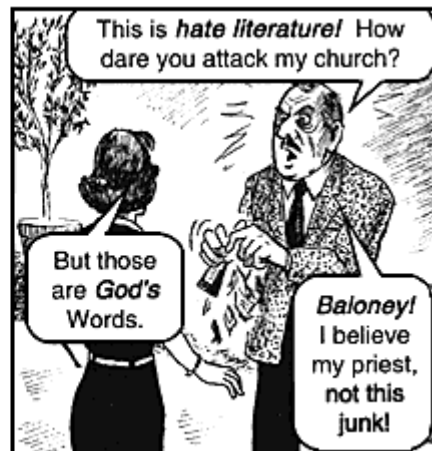
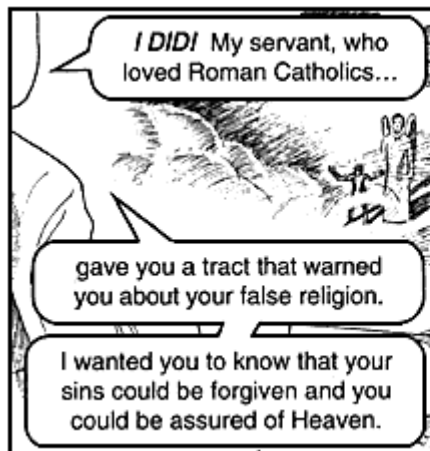
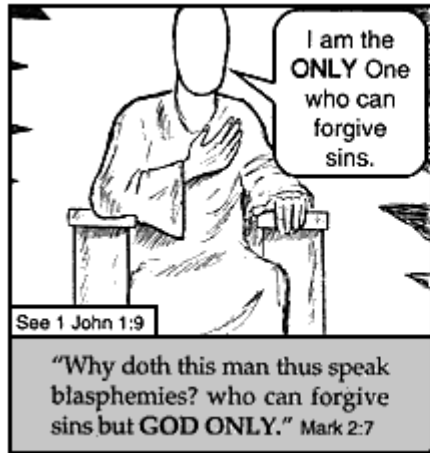
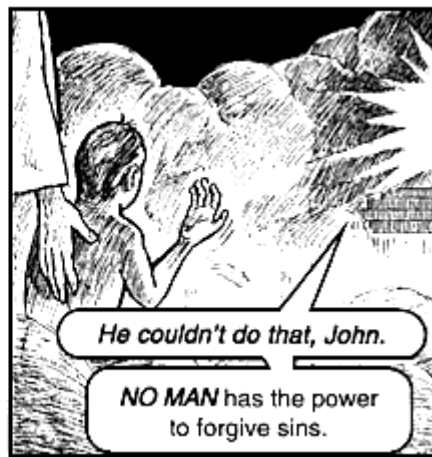
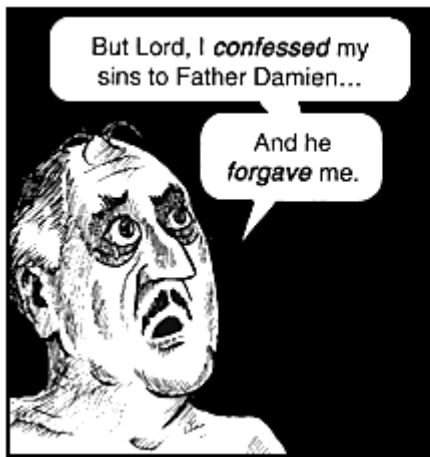
But I thought being baptized as a baby made me a Christian.

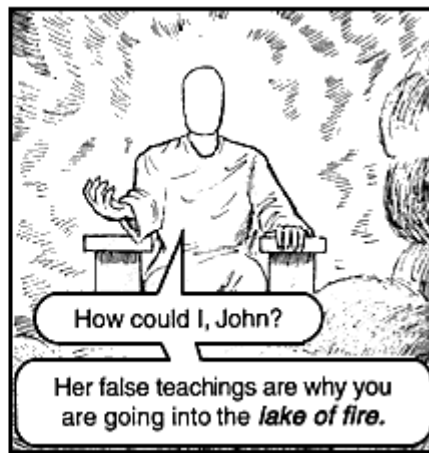
